Amendments to the Yorkshire Ambulance Service Constitution (V.30)

1. PURPOSE/AIM

1.1 To propose amendments to the Yorkshire Ambulance Service Constitution following queries raised at the Trust Board in November 2012.

2. BACKGROUND/CONTEXT

2.1 At the Trust Board Meeting in Public in November the following actions were allocated to the Director of Corporate Affairs and Trust Secretary:

AA to request legal advice on the appropriateness of the wording: "Bradford and Airedale PCT/North Yorkshire and York PCT or its successor in commissioning the Trust's services previously commissioned by that PCT or, if there is more than one such successor, the body commissioning the single largest value of the Trust's services previously commissioned by the PCT".

AA to request legal advice re amendments to the wording of the Police Force Governor.

2.2 Legal Advice was sought from the Trust Solicitors and has now been received and the recommended changes to the wording within Annex 4 of the Yorkshire Ambulance Service Constitution are below:
