1. PURPOSE/AIM

1.1 This paper is presented to inform the Yorkshire Ambulance Service (YAS) Trust Board of the activities of the Charitable Funds Committee and to provide assurance to the to the Trust Board of the discharge of their duty as Corporate Trustee.

2. BACKGROUND/CONTEXT

- 2.1 The Charitable Funds Committee usually meets bi-monthly.
 Unfortunately the 12 February 2013 Committee meeting was cancelled due to the extended meeting for Audit Committee. Also it was agreed that the new Fundraising Committee arrangements should be in place and have fed back to ensure that a meeting of the full Committee would be productive. The next Charitable Funds Committee_meeting will now take place on 18 April 2013.
- 2.2 The Committee Terms of Reference have been updated by Michelle Scott, Financial Project Manager. Michelle has also agreed to provide more proactive support to the Committee on an on-going basis.
- 2.3 It has been agreed to disband the Charitable Funds sub-committee and replace this with delegated authority to Finance for routine items expenditure with more specific projects to be discussed and agreed at the Charitable Funds Committee. Regular reports of all expenditure will continue to be presented at the Committee.
- 2.4 A letter has been drafted and sent to members of the sub-committee to advise them of this change in Committee arrangements, thank them for all their hard work over the years and to invite them to be part of the new Fundraising Committee.
- 2.5 A meeting was arranged with the Chairman of Charitable Funds
 Committee and Executive Director of Finance & Performance with a
 member of the Partnership team at Yorkshire Air Ambulance (YAA) on
 11 March to discuss possible partnership working. However this was
 unfortunately cancelled at their request and is being rescheduled to
 take place before the next meeting of the Committee in April..
- 2.6 The first meeting of the Fundraising Committee will be scheduled early April prior to the Charitable Funds Committee meeting on 18 April 2013.
- 2.7 A training event proposal has been sourced to provide an update on the governance of NHS Charitable Funds for Trust Board members. This will be provided free of charge by Capsticks and a date for this training will be confirmed shortly.
- 2.8 The Corporate Communications team are producing a new Charitable Funds Communications Plan, including the re-launch of the charity.
