ANNUAL GOVERNANCE STATEMENT

1. PURPOSE

1.1 The purpose of this paper is to present the Annual Governance Statement for financial year 2012/13.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Trust's Accountable Officer is required to provide assurance about the stewardship of the organisation through the completion of an Annual Governance Statement.
- 2.2 The Annual Governance Statement gives a sense of how successfully the Trust has coped with the challenges it faced and of how vulnerable the Trust's performance is or might be. This statement draws together position statements and evidence on governance, risk management and internal control.
