1. PURPOSE/AIM

1.1 Provide assurance to the Board on activities related to Emergency Preparedness Response and Recovery and Special Operations (EPRR) for 2014/5 in meeting our status as a Category 1 Responder, and EPRR Statement of Compliance for the NHS.

2. CONTEXT

- 2.1 As a Category 1 Responder under the Civil Contingences Act 2004 (CCA) YAS has to ensure its activities within the field of Emergency Preparedness, Response and Recovery (including Special Operations) are aligned to the requirements of the Act.
- 2.2 Each year YAS Board has to sign off the EPRR Statement of Compliance as required by NHS England.
- 2.3 The Resilience and Special Services Department report to the board key activities each month throught the Integrated Performance Report (IPR).
- 2.4 The Annual Report is an Internal Audit requirement following an audit of HART-Community Resilience. The annual report will be supplemented by a six monthly interim report on EPRR (September 2015)
- 2.5 This Annual Report therefore supports the in-year Statement of Compliance, and brings together the twelve individual IPR reports as well as other supporting information to provide additional assurance to the board that we are meeting the requirements of the CCA 2004 and fulfilling our strategic objective of 'Being at the forefront of healthcare resilience'.
