1. PURPOSE/AIM

2. BACKGROUND/CONTEXT

- 2.1 This Strategy describes the framework which enables implementation of effective risk management and which promotes continuous improvement of the processes and cultures which are essential to delivery. The document also describes a systematic corporate process for evaluating and addressing the impact of risk across all Trust functions.
- 2.2 Minimal changes have been made to this Strategy to reflect updates to the committee structure.
- 2.3 Review and comments have been sought from Trust Management Group, Quality Committee and Audit Committee. Amendments have been made accordingly.
