1. PURPOSE/AIM

That the Trust Board approves the YAS Forum Annual Report 2014-2015.

2. BACKGROUND/CONTEXT

- 2.1 The Terms of Reference (TOR) of YAS Forum (Monitoring and Review, 11.1) require an annual report, through the Chairman, to the Trust Board. This, the first of such reports, fulfils that requirement.
- 2.2 YAS Forum (14 July 2015) received the Annual Report 2014-2015 (the Report) for review and feedback, as did members of the Foundation Trust Development Group (FTDG) (9 July 2015).

3. PROPOSALS/NEXT STEPS

3.1 Following approval of the Report, it is intended to distribute it to all YAS' Members (electronically where possible), the Trust Board, and a wide range of stakeholders including free First Aid training, Private & Events, Community First Responder and Voluntary Car Driver initiatives. It will form part of the FT engagement suite of materials and events led by YAS' Membership Manager.

4. RISK ASSESSMENT
