<p><b>2. Condition G5 - Having regard to monitor Guidance.</b></p>	<p>Yes</p>	<p>This is a statement of intent to comply with guidance issued by Monitor. If the Trust Board answered 'No' it would need to declare which parts of section 96(2) of the 2012 Act it would not have regard to. Evidence of Assurance includes: Trust Board &amp; Committee Structure including independent Audit Committee; Board Assurance Framework (Trust Board 3 x per annum); Significant Incidents &amp; Lessons Learned (Trust Board 2 x per annum); Annual Report, Annual Accounts &amp; Disclosure Statements, Quality Account, Annual Governance Statement Board Memorandum on Quality Governance, External Audit Report For Those Charged with Governance; Integrated Business Plan; Risk Assessment Framework; Standing Orders/Standing Financial Instructions. The Trust received the draft CQC report in May 2015 and submitted a response in regard to factual accuracy by the deadline of 3 June 2015. The final report will be published 21 August 2015 following the Quality Summit 18 August 2015. The Trust has finalised an Action plan to address the issues raised and the improvements required and this has been presented to Quality Committee on 10 September 2015 and submitted to the CQC on 15 September 2015. The action plan was presented to the Trust Board 29 September 2015.</p>
<p><b>4. Condition G8 - Patient eligibility and selection criteria.</b></p>	<p>Yes</p>	<p>This is in regard to setting transparent eligibility and selection criteria, which is not applicable within the A&amp;E and NHS 111 services. PTS eligibility criteria are set at national level by DH (URL attached). YAS implement the criteria by use of flowcharts attached.</p>
<p><b>5. Condition P1 - Recording of information.</b></p>	<p>Yes</p>	<p>This refers to "If required in writing by Monitor, and only in relation to periods from the date of that requirement" and so is merely a statement of intent that the Trust would adhere to Monitor's request if made.</p>
