YOUR LUNGS

When you breathe in through your nose or mouth the air travels down your windpipe and fills up your lungs like two balloons.

Your lungs are an amazing network of tiny tubes that allow the oxygen you breathe to move into your blood through tiny air bags called alveoli.

Breathing is helped by a muscle under the lungs called the diaphragm.
