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#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This report provides an update since the last report presented to the Board on 27 July 2023.

#### 2 BOARD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

- 2.1 <u>Integrated Development Ltd</u> the Trust have commissioned them to facilitate a programme of board development. Chris Lake the lead facilitator will be observing our board meetings on 26<sup>th</sup> October.
- 2.2 Online board health check survey will be circulated shortly to:

- 2.3 <u>Virtual 1:1 discovery interviews</u> (45-60 minute) will be held with each board member and Director who attends board between 6 and 22 November. An email will be sent to arrange.
- 2.4 <u>Board development workshop</u> the first board development workshop is scheduled for 11 January a full day event 9.30-16.30.

### 3 INSIGHT PROGRAMME: Aspirant Non-Executive Director

- 3.1 The Trust has engaged with the Insight Programme for aspirant Non-Executive Directors, run by the recruitment company GatenbySanderson. The Insight Programme provides a structured development programme to support individuals to work towards being a future candidate for Non-Executive Director roles. Individuals who participate in the programme undertake a six-month placement at a host organisation, during which time they gain experience, insight and opportunities similar to existing Non-Executive Directors (although during this placement they have no formal duties or official status).
- 3.2 The Trust has been selected to host a placement in the next cohort of the Insight Programme. Our participant is Carole Hodgson-Mullings who is a director with Citizens Advice. Carole will commence her induction with the Trust in November, supported by the Director of Corporate Services (Company Secretary), and her placement will last until May. During this period Anne Cooper will act as 'Buddy NED' for Carole, and as Chair I will put in place a series of mentoring sessions with Carole.
