## Executive summary (overview of main points)

A refreshed research strategy for the YAS Research Institute (YASRI) was approved at Clinical Governance Group in May. The 2024-2027 strategy with accompanying workplan lays out the next steps for YAS to maintain and develop its prominence as a leader in ambulance-sector research.

One of the key aims of the previous YAS research strategy was the development and launch of an Academic Research Unit, that embeds YAS in key Higher Education Institutions with a growth in our portfolio of projects. The YAS Research Institute (YASRI) was officially launched in October 2023 and this new strategy seeks to capitalise on the success of the YASRI, to set the direction for ambulance research, be trusted to deliver high quality projects that create impact for the improvement of ambulance care.
