Dear colleagues,

Many of us will be deeply shocked by yesterday's terrible attack on a synagogue in Manchester, especially as it occurred on Yom Kippur, the holiest day in the Jewish calendar. This event is deeply upsetting, and our thoughts are with everyone affected. We stand in solidarity with our Jewish colleagues during this difficult time.

We recognise that colleagues from Jewish, as well as other faiths, may have friends or family who are feeling anxious following the news of an attack at a place of worship.

As we said in our joint message of 26 September, racism, discrimination, or abuse of any kind will never be tolerated at YAS.
